The competition is open to All owner/rider combinations riding horses in Grades 3 & 4 (horses not to have won over 21 points). Each combination can accumulate points BUT ONLY at qualifying events at West Wilts in the Archie Foundation Owner Rider Championship.

Points will be awarded from 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> place (10 for 1<sup>st</sup> to 1 for 10<sup>th</sup>). Horse/Rider Combinations must compete in ALL THREE British Eventing Events held at West Wilts during the 2023 season. No points are awarded for double clear rounds. The usual BE balloting rules will apply for all competitions at West Wilts during 2023.

The overall winner will be the combination gaining the most points (as awarded above) in all classes over the 2023 season.

Each combination must remain the same throughout the season & must be direct family owned.

If the rider/owner surname is different it is your responsibility to let us know.

In the event of equality of points, the final placings will be decided by the competitor closest to the collective optimum XC times over all the events that they have competed in, and that rider will be deemed the higher placed. The organiser reserves the right to refuse or disqualify any entry, and to interpret the rules to ensure the efficient and fair running of the competition within the objectives and priorities
